Make your own Insect

Have you always wanted to have your own pet grasshopper or butterfly? Instead of taking an insect out of its home, you can make your own insect using natural materials in your back yard or local park!

Some materials you can use :

- sticks
- bark
- rocks
- leaves
- dirt
- anything else you can find that will make your insect look like the ones you find outside!

You can make your own grasshopper using leaves as the abdomen and thorax, grass as the antennae and small flowers as the eyes. Or make a cockroach using bark, rocks, and dirt! You can even tape your insect into your nature journal so you'll have it with you forever.

While building your insect, remember to only use DDD (dead, down and decomposing) materials!
